Position Summary:

The Information Technology Auditor is a professional position reporting to the Senior Lead, Finance & Corporate Audit Services and/or Senior Lead, Operational Audit Services.

The position works with a high degree of independence and in concert with Senior Lead, Finance & Corporate Audit Services/Senior Lead, Operational Audit Services, and the Senior Internal Audit Lead, Information Technology, to plan and implement programs and processes. The position develops and manages various initiatives and/or programs and provides ongoing client support between individuals, departments, sites and programs.

The position will interpret client needs, assess requirements and identify solutions to non standard issues and requests. The position works to ensure Alberta Health Services values, goals and principles are implemented and integrated in the delivery of services to client groups.

The position is also responsible for:

- Conducting Information Technology audits of IT processes, Applications, and IT General Controls in accordance with the Professional Standards of IT Auditing
- Identifying opportunities where enhancements to internal controls can be cost effectively achieved in Information Systems (IS) security and operations.
- Assessing whether the technical functions as part of IT or broad scope audits of controls, governance and/or risk (i.e. network security, change management, IT governance)

Qualifications:

A minimum of A University degree in Computer Science or a related discipline.

A recognized information systems audit or security management designation (e.g., CISA, CISM or CISSP) is preferred. Previous experience of at least three years in IT Audit / Security in an organization of significant size, complexity and diversity is preferred (healthcare experience an asset) in a senior project management role.
